

## **Directions to Touro Restaurant**

# Touro Restaurant is at 2 Sh. A. Nachon Street, in Mishkenot Sha'ananim near Yemin Moshe.

Touro is a kosher meat Chef restaurant featuring a Mediterranean menu. It is located at the heart of the picturesque Mishkenot Sha'ananim neighborhood, overlooking the breathtaking views of the Old City's walls and the Tower of David.

The restaurant is named after Judah Touro (1775-1854), an American-Jewish philanthropist whose generous donation enabled the establishment of the neighborhood.

The restaurant is housed in a historic building, at the former location of the renowned restaurant by Chef Moise Pe'er, frequented by legendary Mayor Teddy Kollek and his guests. The building, designated for historic preservation, is right at the foot of the historic windmill built by Moses Montefiore and adjacent to the Mishkenot Sha'ananim Guest House, hosting artists and intellectuals.

## By taxi:

Ask the driver to take you to the end of the parking lot of the Montefiore Restaurant in Mishkenot Sha'ananim next to The Jerusalem Music Centre. There you will see stairs, take them down, and on the way down you will see Touro Restaurant towards the bottom on your right.

#### By foot:

From Pardes, German and Greek Colonies, walk or take the **34** bus to Emek Refaim. On Emek Refaim, turn right. Keep walking to the end of Emek Refaim or walking along HaMesilla Park (the railroad tracks footpath). Either way, after you pass First Station, you will be at an intersection. Cross the intersection and continue walking on King David Street. Turn onto Sderot Blumfield, turn left onto Heinrich Heine Street, then right onto Yemin Moshe Street, take the stairs down, and on the way down you will see Touro Restaurant towards the bottom on your right.

From *Derech Beit Lechem*, walk towards First Station. After you pass First Station, you will be at an intersection. Cross the intersection and continue walking on King David Street. Turn onto Sderot Blumfield, turn left onto Heinrich Heine Street, then right onto Yemin Moshe Street, take the stairs down, and on the way down you will see Touro Restaurant towards the bottom on your right.

From the Waldorf Astoria, Mamilla, King David areas: Walk on King David south toward Avraham Mapu, turn left toward Sderot Blumfield, then turn left onto Heinrich Heine Street, then right onto Yemin Moshe Street, take the stairs down, and on the way down you will see Touro Restaurant towards the bottom on your right.



#### By bus:

From *Pardes*, take the **34** bus. Get off at Gan HaPa'amon (Liberty Bell Park)/First Station. Walk on King David Street. Turn onto Sderot Blumfield, turn left onto Heinrich Heine Street, then right onto Yemin Moshe Street, take the stairs down, and on the way down you will see Touro Restaurant towards the bottom on your right.

From *Emek Refaim*, *Baka*, *German and Greek Colonies* take the **18, 34, 77,** or **77A** on Emek Refaim, Get off at Gan HaPa'amon (Liberty Bell Park)/First Station. Walk on King David Street. Turn onto Sderot Blumfield, turn left onto Heinrich Heine Street, then right onto Yemin Moshe Street, take the stairs down, and on the way down you will see Touro Restaurant towards the bottom on your right.

From Derech Beit Lechem, take the **7, 71, 72, 74** or **75** Get off at First Station, walk to King David Street. Walk on King David Street. Turn onto Sderot Blumfield, turn left onto Heinrich Heine Street, then right onto Yemin Moshe Street, take the stairs down, and on the way down you will see Touro Restaurant towards the bottom on your right.

From the center of town, take the **18, 18A, 74, 75, 78,** or **78A** buses to Shalom Aleichem/Keren HaYesod, walk southeast toward Shalom Aleichem, turn left onto Shalom Aleichem, turn right onto Keren HaYesod, turn left onto King David, turn right onto Sderot Blumfield, turn left onto Heinrich Heine Street, turn right onto Yemin Moshe Street, take the stairs down, and on the way down you will see Touro Restaurant towards the bottom on your right.
