The “classic” program

The Pardes Day School Educators Program – training outstanding Jewish studies teachers for day schools since 2000 – is a vibrant and innovative two-year program in Jerusalem that combines intensive text study at the Pardes Institute of Jewish Studies with a Master of Jewish Education from the Shoolman Graduate School at Hebrew College.

The Pardes Experiential Educators Program – One-Year Certificate in Jewish Studies is a one-year program in Jerusalem designed to enrich the careers of experiential Jewish educators through classical Jewish text study, increased Jewish literacy, professional seminars and active participation in the dynamic and diverse community of Pardes.

The Pardes Experiential Educators Program – Two-Year Master of Arts in Jewish Education is designed for experiential educators who want to live and study in Israel for one to two years. The program combines classical Jewish text study at the Pardes Institute of Jewish Studies with an online MA from The Jewish Theological Seminary’s William Davidson School of Education.

+ Hebrew College Rabbinical School

The Pardes-Hebrew College Rabbinical School Joint Program trains outstanding rabbis who are passionate about day school teaching and leadership. Within this collaborative arrangement, the two years at Pardes count towards one year of rabbinical studies at Hebrew College, making the joint program a six-year rabbinical studies and Masters program instead of a seven-year endeavor.



+ Yeshivat Maharat Rabbinical School

The Pardes-Yeshivat Maharat Joint PEP Program trains outstanding clergy who are invested in day school teaching and leadership. Within this collaborative arrangement, the two years at Pardes count towards one year of rabbinical studies at Yeshivat Maharat, making the joint program a five-year rabbinical studies and Masters program instead of a six-year endeavor.

The Pardes and Yeshivat Maharat Joint PEEP Program trains outstanding rabbinic leaders for whom Jewish education is their calling. Within this collaborative arrangement, the year at Pardes counts as a mechina year in preparation for rabbinical studies at YM.

+ Yeshivat Chovevei Torah Rabbinical School

The Pardes-YCT Joint PEP Program trains outstanding rabbinic leaders who are passionate about day school teaching and administration. + Jewish Theological Seminary Rabbinical School

Within this collaborative arrangement, a year of study at Pardes followed by a year of study at The William Davidson Graduate School of Jewish Education count towards one year of rabbinical studies at JTS, making the joint program a six-year rabbinical studies and Masters program instead of a seven-year endeavor.
